A PROCLAMATION

**I**N pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section twelve of the Land Act, 1924, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do, hereby proclaim as road the land described in the Schedule hereto.

APPROXIMATE areas of the pieces of land proclaimed as road:—

0	0	23.8	Part Road Reserve on D.P. 10528, being part Section 45, Porirua District; coloured orange.
0	0	7.9	Part Road Reserve on D.P. 10528, being part closed road adjoining Sections 45 and 46, Porirua District; coloured blue.
0	0	1.9	Part Road Reserve on D.P. 10528, being part Section 46, Porirua District; coloured orange.

Situated in Block VII, Belmont Survey District. (S.O. 21102.)

In the Wellington Land District; as the same are more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 118654, deposited in the office of the Minister of Works at Wellington, and thereon coloured as above mentioned.

**W**HEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto is a reserve duly set apart for a site for Road Board offices and buildings:

And whereas it is expedient that the purpose of the reservation over such land shall be changed to a reserve for municipal purposes:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by subsection one (a) of section seven of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, doth hereby declare that the purpose of the reserve described in the Schedule hereto is hereby changed from a reserve for a site for Road Board offices and buildings to a reserve for municipal purposes.
