*Alterations to the Scale of Charges upon the New Zealand Government Railways*

**I**N pursuance of all powers and authorities enabling me under the Government Railways Act, 1926, and its amendments, and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, I, Robert Semple, Minister of Railways, do hereby make the following alterations to the General Scale of Charges made on the 13th day of April, 1939, and published in the supplement, dated the 19th day of April, 1939, to the *New Zealand Gazette* of the 13th day of April, 1939, in force on the New Zealand Government Railways open for traffic.

PASSENGERS

3. RESERVED SEATS

By adding the following new paragraph:—

"7. Any person failing to occupy a seat reserved in accordance with his application, or failing to give notification to a railway booking-office or agency not later than twenty-four hours prior to the scheduled departure time of the train from its starting station of his intention not to occupy such seat, shall pay a surcharge on the following basis:—

Length of Journey.	Surcharge.	
	s.	d.
"Up to 100 miles .. .. .	3	0
"Over 100 miles .. .. .	5	0

"In the case of a seat reserved for a child under fifteen years of age the full surcharge will be payable."
