IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, do hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Dunedin City Council on the thirty-first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and forty-four, viz:—

“That the Dunedin City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the City of Dunedin, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the south-western side of the portion of Bernard Street adjoining Allotment 15, Block VII, D.P. 1829, Township of Barrfield, such land being comprised and described in Certificate of Title 143/213”;
