

LEVIN BOROUGH COUNCIL
RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Levin Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a special loan of three thousand four hundred and fifty pounds (£3,450), authorized to be raised by the Levin Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of reimbursing to the Council's General Account the amount expended therefrom on making extensions and improvements to the Levin Municipal Abattoir, and to pay for the cost of the completion thereof, the Levin Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-eleventh (1/11th) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Borough of Levin; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen (15) years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
