Summary of the Records of Temperature, Rainfall, and Sunshine for April, 1944

Table with columns: Station, Height of Station above M.S.L., Air Temperatures in Degrees (Fahrenheit) [Means of A Max, B Min, Mean of A and B, Difference from Normal, Absolute Maximum and Minimum], Rainfall in Inches [Total Fall, No. of Wet Days, Difference from Normal, Most in a Day], Bright Sunshine (Hours). Includes stations like Te Pahi, Auckland, Christchurch, and Akaroa.

NOTE.—At stations where departure from normal are in parentheses the record has been maintained for less than ten years in the case of temperatures and for less than twenty years in the case of rainfall and the normals are partly interpolated.
