COOK COUNTY COUNCIL

SPECIAL RESOLUTION

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Cook County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £780, authorized to be raised by the Cook County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of repaying the balance of the Spence and Mossman's Bridges Loan, 1929, the said Cook County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ d. (twopence and thirty-one thirty-seconds of one penny in the pound) upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Spence and Mossman's Bridges Special Rating District, comprising Lot 1, S.G.R. 32, Blocks VI and X, Hangaroa Survey District, and part Lot 2, S.G.R. 41, Block X, Hangaroa Survey District; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of July in each and every year during a period equal to the currency of such loan, being a period of ten years or until the loan is fully paid off. The rate of interest to be 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ per cent.”

The above resolution was passed by the Cook County Council on the 19th day of April, 1944.
