IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby consent to the Bay of Islands County Council stopping the portion of road described in the Schedule hereto.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of road permitted to be stopped: 2 acres 1 rood 38 perches. Adjoining or passing through Allotments part 177, 178, 179, 229, and 230, Kawakawa Parish, and Section 1.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Otaki Borough Council on the eleventh day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, in so far as it affects the side and portion of the street described in the Schedule hereto, viz.:-

"That the Otaki Borough Council declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to that part of Dunstan Street, Otaki, upon which abuts that piece of land containing 1 rood 1.3 perches, more or less, being Lot 38, Deposited Plan No. 633, Waitohu Survey District";

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the north-western side of the portion of Dunstan Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the south-eastern side of portion of Wynyard Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of twenty-five feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.
