Directing Application of Moneys received in respect of Portion of the Ormond Domain, Gisborne Land District, for the Purposes of the Waihirere and Gray's Bush Domain

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred by section sixty-one of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby direct that from the moneys received in respect of that portion of the Ormond Domain, described in the First Schedule hereto, and at the date hereof lying to the credit of the said domain, a sum not exceeding two hundred and fifty pounds shall be applied in managing, administering, and improving the Waihirere and Gray's Bush Domain described in the Second Schedule hereto.

WHEREAS the Grey County Council (hereinafter called "the WHEREAS the Grey County Council (hereinafter called "the said local authority") proposes, pursuant to the provisions of section three of the Main Highways Amendment Act, 1928, to borrow the sum of one thousand five hundred pounds (£1,500), by a loan to be known as "Main Highways Loan, 1944" (hereinafter called "the said loan"), for the purpose of paying its portion of the cost of carrying out improvement work on the Westport-Greymouth (Coast Road) Main Highway between Runanga to Rapahoe:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, and in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by section eleven of the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926, as set out in

and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by section eleven of the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926, as set out in section twenty-nine of the Finance Act, 1932 (No. 2), and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby consent to the raising by the said local authority of the said loan for the said purpose up to the amount of one thousand five hundred pounds (£1,500), and in giving such consent doth hereby determine as follows: as follows:

(1) The term for which the said loan or any part thereof may

(1) The term for which the said loan or any part thereof may be raised shall be five (5) years.

(2) The rate of interest that may be paid in respect of the said loan or any part thereof shall be such as shall not produce to the lender or lenders a rate exceeding three pounds fifteen shillings

(£3 15s.) per centum per annum.

(3) The said loan, together with interest thereon, shall be repaid by equal aggregate annual instalments extending over the term as determined in (1) above.

(4) No moneys shall be borrowed under this consent after the expiration of two years from the date hereof.
