NEWALL, Governor-General IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers and authorities in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominon of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Warrant dated the third day of August, one thousand nine hundred and seven, and published in the New Zealand Gazette No. 71 of the eighth day of the same month vesting the control of the bridge known as the Taramakau Bridge, together with the approaches thereto, in the Kumara Borough Council and apportioning the cost of maintenance of the said bridge, and do hereby direct that the Taramakau Bridge, together with approaches thereto (described in the Schedule hereto) shall, on and after the date of the gazetting hereof, be under the control of the Grey County Council: And, in further pursuance and exercise of the powers aforesaid.

Grey County Council: And, in further pursuance and exercise of the powers aforesaid, I do hereby fix and determine that the cost of maintaining the said bridge and the approaches thereto, less such contribution (if any) as may be made thereto by the Government of New Zealand or the Main Highways Board, shall be borne by the Kumara Borough Council, the Grey County Council, and the Westland County Council in the following proportions, viz. : The Kumara Borough Council shall pay five-twelfths of such cost, the Grey County Council shall pay five-twelfths of such cost, and the Westland County Council shall pay two-twelfths of such cost respectively ; and I do also further direct that any contribution hereby required to be made as aforesaid by the Kumara Borough Council and the Westland County Council shall be paid from time to time in the proportion herein-before prescribed out of the funds of the said Borough Council and before prescribed out of the funds of the said Borough Council and County Council respectively within a period of one month after demand in writing made by or on behalf of the Grey County Council, and that such payment shall be made from time to time to the Clerk of the Grey County Council for and on behalf of the Grey County Council.
