A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it has been found desirable for the use, convenience, and enjoyment of the Stratford Main Trunk Railway to take further land near Ohura in addition to land previously acquired for the purposes of the said railway:

Now, therefore, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on me by sections thirty-four and two hundred and sixteen of the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes above mentioned.

Allocating Railway Land to the Purposes of Street in the Borough of Carterton

A PROCLAMATION

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land which is described in the Schedule hereto (and which was taken for the Wellington-Napier Railway, and is not now required for such purpose) shall, upon the publication hereof in the *New Zealand Gazette*, become street, and that such street shall be maintained by the Carterton Borough Council in like manner as other streets are controlled and maintained by the said Council.
