Prohibition of the Sale of Declared Goods under Clause 9 (2) of the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment

PURSUANT to the powers conferred on it by clause 9 (2) of the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 3,* the Price Tribunal hereby prohibits the sale by any persons whomsoever, on and after the 11th day of September, 1944, of any goods of a kind or class specified in the Schedule hereto (being goods goods of a kind of class specimed in the Schedule hereto (being goods that have been declared under the Declared Goods (Control of Prices) Notice 1944 (No. 1))†.

The prohibition of the sale by any person of any goods in accordance with this notice shall cease to have effect with respect

to such goods-

(a) If and when a Price Order issued by the Tribunal comes

into force with respect to those goods; or

(b) If and when the Tribunal authorizes to such person a selling-price or a maximum selling-price for such goods.

SCHEDULE

Classes of Goods the Sale of which is prohibited by this Notice

1. Garments of any of the following kinds, namely:-

Bathing suits and shorts, dressing-gowns, house coats, lumber jackets, nightdresses, skirts, women's shorts and slacks.

2. Handkerchiefs.
