RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Water-supply Loan, £9,000 (1944)

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Health Act, 1920, the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Woodville Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, principal, and other charges on a loan of nine thousand pounds (£9,000), authorized to be raised by the Woodville Borough Council pursuant to the provisions of section 24 of the Health Act, 1920, for the purpose of providing waterworks to improve the public water-supply of the Borough of Woodville and complying with a requisition issued under section 22 of the Health Act, 1920, the Woodville Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three decimal two nought pence (3.20d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the whole of the Borough of Woodville; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable on the 1st day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five (25) years or until the loan is fully paid off."
