Alteration of Boundaries of Puketitiri Fire District

WHEREAS by a notice published in the Gazette on the 10th day of February, 1927, at page 412 (hereinafter referred to as "the said notice"), a certain area in the Hawke's Bay Land District was declared to be a fire district under section 27 of the Forests Act, 1921–22, and named the Puketitiri Fire District:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 27 of the Forests Act, 1921–22, and section 6 of the Forests Amendment Act, 1925, and on the recommendation of the Director of Forestry and of the Land Board of the Hawke's Bay Land District, I hereby revoke the said notice, and do declare the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a fire district to be known as the "Puketitiri Fire District," and, with respect to the fire district constituted as aforesaid, I do further specify the period from the 1st day of November in any year to the 31st day of March in the following year, inclusive, as the period during which it shall not be lawful for any person within the said district, save pursuant to the written permit of a Forest Officer, to set on fire or cause to be set on fire any timber, whether standing or not, or any undergrowth, or any debris from forest operations, or or not, or any undergrowth, or any debris from forest operations, or any grass or other specially inflammable material, without taking such precautions as may be prescribed by a Forest Officer.
