IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Motueka Borough Council on the twelfth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and forty-four, viz.:-

"The Motueka Borough Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the Borough of Motueka, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the northern side of the portion of Parker Street adjoining subdivision of part Reserve F (Section 186, part Section 159), District of Motueka, Blocks III and IV, Motueka Survey District (C.T. 62/29)";

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the northern side of the portion of Parker Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.
