Now, therefore, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section eight of the Scenery Preservation Amendment Act, 1910, do hereby revoke the reservation for scenic purposes over the land described in the Schedule hereto.

#### SCHEDULE

#### AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

ALL that area in the Rotorua County, situated in Block IV, Horohoro Survey District, containing by admeasurement 24 acres 3 roods, more or less, being parts Rotohokahoka D North No. 2B and part Rotohokahoka D South Nos. 10A and B Blocks, and being the land on plan S.O. 31994. As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked L. and S. 4/231A, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon edged red.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, and issued under the Seal of that Dominion, this 2nd day of November, 1944.

And whereas the district known as the Kokonga-Tiroiti Rabbit District has been constituted under and for the purposes of the said Act:

And whereas the Board of the said district has, pursuant to the said section thirty-one of the said Act, requested that the boundaries of its district be altered and redefined by including an additional area therein:

And whereas the consent of the occupier of the land comprised in such additional area qualified to be enrolled on the ratepayers' list for the said district has been given to the inclusion of such additional area in the said district:

And whereas it is deemed expedient to alter and redefine the boundaries of the said district accordingly:

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by the said Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby—

- (1) Alter and redefine the boundaries of the said district so constituted as aforesaid;
- (2) Declare that the boundaries of the said district shall be those set forth in the Schedule hereto; and, further,
- (3) Declare that this Order in Council shall come into force on the day following publication hereof in the Gazette.

BOUNDARIES OF THE KOKONGA-TIROITI RABBIT DISTRICT
