the approximate times of high and low water at 104 places in the Dominion may be found; and tidal-stream predictions giving the approximate daily times of the flood and ebb streams making at Tory Channel and French Pass. List of New Zealand lighthouses, radio beacons, and fog signals;

List of New Zealand lighthouses, radio beacons, and fog signals; list of latest dated charts of the New Zealand coast and harbours; list of licensed adjusters and coastal pilots, &c.; and a summary of alterations to bring the Port Information in the 1942 edition and Part II, 1943, up to 30th September, 1944.
