WAIHEMO COUNTY COUNCIL

By LAW No. 2

Prohibiting the Cutting of Grass for Seed on Roads and Streets

In pursuance and exercise of the powers, provisions, and authorities vested in it in that behalf by the Counties Act, 1920, and section 161 of the Public Works Act, 1928, or otherwise enabling it in that behalf, the Council of the County of Waihemo doth hereby, by special order, make and ordain the following

by-law:—

1. The short title of this by-law shall be "The Waihemo Council By-law No. 2 (Prohibiting the Cutting of Grass for Seed on all Roads and Streets) 1944."

2. This by-law shall read as follows: The Waihemo County Council prohibits the cutting of grass for seed on all roads and streets within the County of Waihemo without the previous consent in writing of the said Council.

3. Every person who infringes this by-law or who refuses to comply with any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a penalty not exceeding ten pounds (£10).

The above by-law was duly made by special order passed at a special meeting of the Waihemo County Council on the 18th day of September, 1944, and confirmed at an ordinary meeting of the said Council held at 11 o'clock in the forenoon on the 24th day of October, 1944, and ordered to come into operation on the 11th day of December, 1944.
