Declaring Portions of Railway Land at Blenheim to be Crown Land

A PROCLAMATION

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land subject to the Land Act, 1924.

APPROXIMATE areas of the pieces of land :—

0	0	10-83	Part Section 3 (Drain Reserve), Omaka District; coloured blue. Plan L.O. 7062. (S.O. 3759.)
0	2	39-5	Lots 1 and 2, Railway land, being portions of Allotments 578, 579, 580, and 581, Town of Blenheim, being part of Section 1, Omaka District; bordered yellow. Plan W.R. 19833. (S.O. 981.)
