Revocation of the Reservation of Portions of Permanent State Forest, North Auckland Land District

A PROCLAMATION

BY virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the Forests Act, 1921-22, and pursuant to a resolution in that behalf passed by both Houses of Parliament—that is to say, by the Legislative Council on the thirtieth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty-four, and by the House of Representatives on the thirteenth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and forty-four—I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke (so far only as it relates to the lands described in the Schedule hereto) the Proclamations of the eighteenth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, published in the *Gazette* on the twenty-eighth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, at page 587, and the twenty-ninth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three, published in the *Gazette* on the fourth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three, at page 1215, respectively, whereby the said lands (with certain other lands) were set apart as permanent State forests, and declare that the reservation thereby effected is (so far only as aforesaid) revoked accordingly.
