Crown Land set apart for the Wellington - New Plymouth Railway in Block VI, Ngaere Survey District

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Yorlon Newal, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby set apart for the Wellington – New Plymouth Railway; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the nineteenth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-five.
