AREA PROPOSED TO BE EXCLUDED FROM THE COUNTY OF HEATHCOTE AND INCLUDED IN THE CITY OF CHRISTCHURCH

ALL that area in the County of Heathcote, Canterbury Land District, bounded by a line commencing at a point on the northern side of Roscoe Street in line with the eastern boundary of Lot 13 on plan deposited in the Canterbury District Land Registry Office at Christchurch as No. 8624, being a point on the boundary of the City of Christchurch (*New Zealand Gazette*, 1944, pages 1254 and 1508); thence in a southerly direction by a right line to and along the eastern boundary of the said Lot 13 and the eastern boundary of Lot 9, on plan deposited as aforesaid as No. 8624, to Leonard Street; thence easterly along the northern side of that street and its production to a point on the boundary of the City of Christchurch; thence north-westerly and easterly along that boundary to the point of commencement.
