Plan 31558, being part of Allotment 43 of the said Whangape Parish, to and along the north-western side of Broughton's Road, to and across Ruawaro Road, along the northern side of the last-mentioned road, along the northern side of the main highway, and along the western side of Pukekopia Road to a point being the production north-westward of the south-west boundary of Section 2, Block XI, Rangiriri Survey District; thence along a right line across that road and along the south-western boundary of the said Section 2, the north-western boundary of Allotment 28, Pepepe Parish, and its production across a public road, and along the north-western boundary of part Allotment 171A of the said parish, and its production north-westward across a public road and the Waikato River, to the point of commencement.
