WHEREAS by an Order in Council dated the third day of March, one thousand nine hundred and eight, and published in the *Gazette* of the twelfth day of that month, the control of certain reserves was vested in the Minister of the Crown for the time being having the administration of the Tourist and Health Resorts Control Act, 1906:

And whereas it is expedient that the aforesaid Order in Council should be revoked over portion of the land described in the Schedule thereto:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby revoke the Order in Council of the third day of March, one thousand nine hundred and eight, aforesaid, in so far as concerns the land described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

CANTERBURY LAND DISTRICT.—PART HANMER THERMAL SPRINGS RESERVE

WHEREAS a notice of intention to issue an Order in Council declaring that the reservation as a public reserve for recreation purposes over the land described in the First Schedule hereto shall be revoked was published in the *Gazette* of the thirtieth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty-four:

And whereas such notice of intention was duly laid before both Houses of Parliament in accordance with the provisions of subsection two of section seven of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928:

And whereas the Legislative Council and the House of Representatives, by resolutions dated respectively the eighth and the thirteenth days of December, one thousand nine hundred and forty-four, approved the proposed revocation as aforesaid:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred by subsection one (b) of section seven of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby revoke the reservation as a public reserve for recreation purposes over the land described in the First Schedule hereto, and doth hereby declare that the said land, being vested in the body corporate called the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Christchurch, may be disposed of by the said body corporate by way of sale or other disposition on such terms and conditions as the said body corporate shall determine, but so that the proceeds of any such sale shall be used and applied in or towards recouping the said body corporate for the moneys expended by it in the purchase for recreation purposes of the land described in the Second Schedule hereto.
