

- (11) The property of the New Zealand Refrigeration Co., Ltd., near Templeton, Islington, and Hornby, containing by admeasurement 285 acres 1 rood 23 perches, and being Rural Sections 3998, 3077, 4205, part 4382, 9199, 13501, 1983, 3213, and 330; as the same is delineated more particularly on a plan numbered I.A. 52/49, deposited in the Head Office of the Department of Internal Affairs, Wellington, being thereon outlined in red.
- (12) All that area of land at Flaxton, 1 chain in width, including the roadway on either side of the main drain, extending in a westerly direction from the Skew Bridge to Smith's Road, a distance of two miles, comprising part Rural Sections 1762, 1446, 1621, 1613, 1220, 1640, 2066, 1283, 2010, 1693, 1695, 1685, 1616, 1221, 1058, 1168, and 404, Rangiora Survey District.
- (13) All that area of land containing 62 acres, more or less, at Coutts Island, in the Land District of Canterbury, and being parts of Rural Sections 2208, 2272, 2383, 2384, and a portion of closed road, situated in Block II of the Christchurch Survey District; as shown on plan marked I.A. 46/16/25, deposited in the Head Office of the Department of Internal Affairs at Wellington, being thereon edged in red.

WELLINGTON ACCLIMATIZATION DISTRICT

(As described in *New Zealand Gazette* No. 54 of 19th August, 1937, at page 1847.)

- Season for hares, cock pheasants, Californian quail, and Australian quail: 12th May to 31st July, 1945 (both days inclusive).
- Season for grey duck, mallard duck, shoveller duck, pukeko, and black swan: 12th May to 27th May, 1945 (both days inclusive).
- Licenses to take or kill such imported game and native game within the Wellington Acclimatization District will be issued to any person on payment of the sum of thirty shillings (30s.) each: Provided that licenses to take or kill imported game and native game within the said district will be issued to any person receiving an age benefit or a miner's benefit under the Social Security Act, 1938, on payment of the sum of twenty shillings (20s.) each; and the Secretary of the Wellington Acclimatization Society, or any person authorized by such Secretary in that behalf, is hereby authorized to sign and issue the said licenses.

4. No person shall in any one day take or kill more than—

- Two head of cock pheasants;
- Five head of black swan;
- Fifteen head in all of grey duck, mallard duck, and/or spoonbill duck; and
- Five head of pukeko.

5. Nothing herein shall apply to hares in the counties of Akitio, Castlepoint, Masterton, Pahiatua, Featherston, and Wairarapa South, or in the area formerly included in the Feilding and District Acclimatization District, as described in *New Zealand Gazette* No. 17 of 12th March, 1925, at page 750, wherein these animals are not protected.

6. No person shall take or kill native or imported game on the 12th, 13th, or 14th days of May, 1945, while occupying any stand, hide, loo, or position as commonly used by duck-shooters (hereinafter referred to as "a stand") which has been duly claimed by any other license-holder in accordance with the following provisions:—

- A stand may be claimed by the planting thereon at any time after noon on the 5th day of May, 1945, of a stake with a board attached having plainly marked thereon the name and address of the claimant and the number of his license.
- No person shall claim more than one stand.
- No stand shall be claimed on or within 100 yards of a stand which has already been duly claimed by any other person, except with the consent of such last-mentioned person.

Provided, however, that any stand which is not occupied by the claimant by 7 a.m. on any of the aforesaid days may be occupied on that day by any other license-holder.

Provided further that nothing in this clause contained shall be deemed to affect in any way whatsoever the rights of owners or occupiers of any lands in respect of shooting on such lands.

7. Excepted areas wherein imported game and/or native game shall not be taken or killed during the open season:—

- The Awapuni Lagoon situated on the property of the Manawatu Racing Club.
- Lot 1, D.P. 3184, part Rural Section 364, Palmerston North, containing 23 acres 1 rood 20 perches, the property of the Kairanga County Council.
- The Glenmorven Estate, situated in the Paraekaretu Block, being Section 1, Block XI, Onga Survey District; Sections 124 and 125, Paraekaretu Block, and closed road and Lots 1/4, D.P. 9948, being part Section 2, Block XI, Onga Survey District, and part Hapapo Block; also Sections 118/9, 121/2, and part Sections 114/5, 116/7, Paraekaretu Block, and closed road, Block XI, Onga Survey District; also Sections 113 to 120, Block XI, Onga Survey District, being the property of Mr. Grant Simpson, of Hunterville.
- All the land contained in Proclamation No. 1561, being Block IV, Belmont Survey District, and being part of Section 179, Hutt District, and contained in certificate of title, Vol. 358, folio 34, Wellington Registry, being the property of the Hutt River Board.

Redefining Boundaries of the City of Lower Hutt, the County of Hutt, and the Eponi and the Wainuiomata Ridings of the County of Hutt

PURSUANT to the provisions of section 147 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, the boundaries of the City of Lower Hutt are hereby defined as set out in the First Schedule hereto, the boundaries of the said city having been altered by Order in Council made under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, dated the 4th day of October, 1944, and published in *Gazette* No. 82 of the 5th day of October, 1944:

And also, in pursuance of the provisions of the said section 147 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, the boundaries of the County of Hutt affected by the said Order in Council are hereby defined as set out in the Second Schedule hereto:

And, in further pursuance of the provisions of the said section 147 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, the boundaries of the Eponi Riding of the County of Hutt affected by the said Order in Council are hereby defined as set out in the Third Schedule hereto:

And, in further pursuance of the provisions of the said section 147 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, the boundaries of the Wainuiomata Riding of the County of Hutt affected by the said Order in Council are hereby defined as set out in the Fourth Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF LOWER HUTT

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District, situated in Belmont Survey District, bounded by a line commencing at the westernmost corner of Section 16, Hutt District, and proceeding generally north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of Sections 16, 20, 24, 28, and 75, Hutt District, to the northernmost corner of Section 75, Hutt District; thence south-easterly and easterly along the northern boundary of Section 75, Hutt District, to its intersection with the eastern side of the Western Hutt Road; thence north-easterly along the eastern side of the Western Hutt Road to the southern boundary of that part of Section 37, Hutt District, granted to Leonard Young by Crown Grant No. 934 (Deeds Index 3/607); thence easterly along the southern boundary of the said part of Section 37, Hutt District, and its production to the western boundary of Section 46, Hutt District; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of Sections 46, 49, 52, 55, and 56, Hutt District, to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence westerly along the southern boundary of part Sub-division 10 of Section 57, Hutt District, shown on Deposited Plan 12710, to the Wellington-Wairarapa Railway; thence north-easterly generally along the Wellington-Wairarapa Railway to a point due west of the northernmost corner of part Section 64, Hutt District, shown on Survey Office Plan 21084; thence easterly along a right line to and along the northern boundary of part Section 64 aforesaid, across the Main Hutt Road, and again along the northern boundary of part Section 64 aforesaid to the north-eastern corner of that section; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 64, 63, 62, Hutt District, and part of the eastern boundary of Section 61, Hutt District, to the northernmost corner of Section 228, Hutt District; thence in a southerly direction generally along the eastern boundary of Section 228 aforesaid and the eastern and part of the southern boundaries of Section 229, Hutt District, to a point distant 440 links from the south-eastern corner of the last-mentioned section; thence south-easterly generally along the north-eastern boundaries of parts Sections 231 and 232 comprised in certificate of title, Vol. 184, folio 177 (Wellington Registry), to the northernmost corner of the land shown on Deposited Plan 12561, being subdivision of parts Sections 231 and 232, Hutt District, and Sections 1 and 2 (D.P. 983), Block XV, Belmont Survey District; thence in a south-westerly direction generally along the north-western boundary of the land shown on the said Deposited Plan 12561 to its intersection with the northern boundary of Section 1 (D.P. 983), Block XV, Belmont Survey District; thence westerly along the northern boundary of Section 1 aforesaid to and along the southern boundary of Section 440, Hutt District, to the westernmost corner of that section; thence along the southern boundary of Section 18s, Waddington Settlement, across Seddon Street, and again along the southern boundary of Section 18s aforesaid and its production across another public road to the north-eastern corner of Lot 1 on Deposited Plan 4581, being portion of Section 21, Lowry Bay District; thence southerly and westerly generally along the eastern and southern boundaries of the said Lot 1 to the westernmost corner of that lot; thence westerly along a right line to the southernmost corner of Section 225, Hutt District; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 27 and 23, Hutt District, to the northernmost corner of part Lot 3 on D.P. 7866, being a subdivision of part of Section 21, Lowry Bay District; thence easterly, southerly, and westerly along the northern, eastern, and southern boundaries of part Lot 3 aforesaid, to and along the southern boundary of Lot 3 on D.P. 11467, being a subdivision of portion of Section 21, Lowry Bay District, to the eastern boundary of Section 238, Hutt District; thence generally southerly along the eastern boundaries
