Taking of Fish for Sale

W. D. Wade, 91 Raven Street, Kaiapoi, has applied for a license to permit him to operate his 15 ft. fishing-vessel "Nancy" (not yet registered), using set-nets, hand-lines, and crayfish-pots, catches to be landed at Kaikoura.
