In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the leasehold estate or interest in the land described in the Schedule hereto, held from Augustine Henry Hart, of New Plymouth, Fancy-goods Dealer, by William Ernest Morris and Percy Morris, both of New Plymouth, Taxi-cab Proprietors, under an agreement for lease dated the ninth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and forty-three, is hereby taken for buildings of the General Government; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the twentieth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and forty-five.
