*Additional Land at Ashburton taken for the Purposes of the Hurunui-Waitaki Railway*

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it has been found desirable for the use, convenience, and enjoyment of the Hurunui-Waitaki Railway to take further land at Ashburton in addition to land previously acquired for the purposes of the said railway:

Now, therefore, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on me by sections thirty-four and two hundred and sixteen of the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes above-mentioned.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land: 2 roods 24 perches.  
Part street adjoining Reserves 299 and 1923.

Situated in the Borough of Ashburton. (S.O. 7593.)

In the Canterbury Land District; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked L.O. 7814, deposited in the office of the Minister of Railways at Wellington, and thereon coloured green.
