HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL WHEREAS the Bay of Islands Electric-power Board (herein-after called "the said local authority"), being desirous of raising a loan of forty-seven thousand pounds (£47,000), to be known as "Reticulation Extension Loan (No. 2), 1945" (hereinafter called "the said loan"), for the purpose of further reticulating the Board's inner area, has complied with the provisions of the Local Govern-ment Loans Board Act, 1926 (hereinafter called "the said Act"): And whereas the said local authority is arranging to raise a portion thereof amounting to twelve thousand pounds (£12,000) (hereinafter called "the said sum"), and it is expedient that the precedent consent of the Governor-General in Council, as required by the said Act, should be given to the raising of the said sum : Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and con-sent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, and in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by

sent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, and in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by section eleven of the said Act, as set out in section twenty-nine of the Finance Act, 1932 (No. 2), and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby consent to the raising in New Zealand by the said local authority of the said sum for the said purpose up to the amount of twelve thousand pounds (£12,000), and in giving such consent doth hereby determine as follows :—

(1) The term for which the said sum or any part thereof may

(2) The rate of interest that may be paid in respect of the said sum or any part thereof shall be such as shall not produce to the lender or lenders a rate exceeding three pounds ten shillings (£3 10s.)

(3) The said sum shall be repaid by half-yearly instalments of principal of not less than three hundred pounds (£300) each, extending over the term as determined in clause one above.

(4) The payment of interest and the repayment of principal in respect of the said sum shall be made in New Zealand.

(5) No amount payable as either interest or as principal in respect of the said sum shall be paid out of loan-moneys.
(6) The rate payable for brokerage, underwriting, and procuration fees in respect of the raising of the said sum or any part thereof shall not in the aggregate exceed one-half per centum of

any amount raised. (7) No moneys shall be borrowed under this consent after the expiration of two years from the date hereof.
