Exemption Order under the Transport Legislation Emergency Regulations 1940

**P**URSUANT to the Transport Legislation Emergency Regulations 1940, the Minister of Transport doth hereby order and declare that the provisions of clause (1) of Regulation 7 of the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940, so far as they relate to the driving of heavy trade motors, shall not apply to the person hereinafter mentioned, but in lieu thereof the following provision shall apply :—

A motor-driver's license issued under the Motor-drivers Regula-tions 1940 to the person described in Column 1 of the Schedule hereunder may authorize him to drive a heavy trade motor for the Column 2 of the said Schedule, but shall not authorize him, while be is under the age of eighteen years, to drive a heavy trade motor-vehicle for any other purpose.

Declaring Area to be a Closely Populated Locality for the Purposes of the Motor vehicles Amendment Act, 1936, Section 3

Notice of Exercise of Powers under the Defence Emergency Regulations 1941

## BOMBING RANGES

IN accordance with the powers conferred on the Minister of Defence under section 18 of the Defence Emergency Regulations 1941, and in accordance with the authority conferred on me by the said Minister of Defence pursuant to section 50 (1) of the Defence Emergency Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 3, I hereby give notice of the establishment of bombing ranges more particularly described as follows :

(a) Danger Area No. 1.—Situated within the Frankhn County and the Maramarua Survey District, being part of Block II. The danger area is all that area within a circle having a radius of 1,000 yards from the target position at latitude 37° 14′ 44″. S. and longitude 175° 04′ 03″ E. This target position is approximately two miles and a half east of Pokeno, and the south perimeter of the danger area almost cuts the new Pokeno-Thames Railway formation.
(b) Danger Area No. 2.—Situated within the North Waikato County and the Maramarua Survey District, being part of Blocks.

(b) Danger Area No. 2.—Situated within the North Waikato County and the Maramarua Survey District, being part of Blocks VII and XI. The danger area is all that area within a circle having a radius of 2,000 yards from the target position at latitude  $37^{\circ}$  20' 16" S. and longitude 175° 07' 53" E. The target position is at a point approximately four miles east of the Waikato River and three miles south of the Maramarua River.
