Conversion Redemption Loan, 1945

"In pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and its amendments, and of all other Acts, powers, and authorities enabling it in that behalf, the Wellington City Council hereby resolves as follows: That, for the purposes of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a special loan of forty thousand pounds (£40,000), to be known as the Wellington City New Office Building Loan, 1942, authorized to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of the provision of office accommodation to replace buildings damaged by earthquake, the Wellington City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of thirty-three eight-hundredths of a penny ($\frac{33}{800}$ d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the whole of the City of Wellington; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the said loan, being a period of twenty (20) years from the 1st day of September, 1945, or until the loan is fully paid off."
