IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Marton Borough Council on the second day of May, one thousand nine hundred and forty-five, viz.:-

"The Marton Borough Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the Borough of Marton, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the eastern side of the portion of Stewart Street adjoining that piece of land being part of Section 17, Rangitikei Agricultural Reserve, in the Town of Marton, and being Lot 1 on Deposited Plan No. 3337, and being part of the land comprised in Certificate of Title, Register-book, Volume 236, folio 130 (Wellington Registry)";
