Taking of Fish for Sale

Messrs. Greenwell, Ltd., Beaumont Street, Auckland, have applied for an industrial fishing license to permit them to operate the fishing-vessel "Briney Marlin," MGN. 162, using set-nets, drag-nets, long lines, hand-lines, and crayfish-pots, catches to be landed at Paerengarenga, Unahi, and Russell.
