IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for a public school and shall vest in the Education Board of the District of Wellington as from the data hereinefter montioned is and I do also declare that this the date hereinafter mentioned; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the first day of October, one thousand nine hundred and forty-five.
