A PROCLAMATION

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke so much of the Proclamation dated the twenty-first day of May, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 44 of the twenty-ninth day of the same month, at page 1465, and deposited in the Land Registry Office at Christchurch as No. 1786, taking land for a Native school in Block II, Arowhenua Survey District, as affects the land described in the Schedule hereto, such land being no longer required.
