Amending a Proclamation proclaiming Land as Road in Block I, Oamaru Survey District, Waitaki County

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Land Act, 1924, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zea-Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zea-land, do hereby amend the Proclamation dated the fifteenth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and forty-five, and published in the New Zealand Gazette No. 54 of the twenty-third day of the same month at page 1044, proclaiming land as road in Block I, Oamaru Survey District, Waitaki County, by deleting from the Schedule to the said Proclamation the areas described in the First Schedule hereto and substituting in lieu thereof the areas described in the Second Schedule hereto.
