

Notice of Intention to take Additional Land for Post and Telegraph Purposes in the Borough of New Plymouth

The Clothing Trade Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1940, No. 2, Amendment No. 3

PURSUANT to the Labour Legislation Emergency Regulations 1940, the Minister of Labour doth hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Clothing Trade Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1940, No. 2, Amendment No. 3.

2. This Order shall be read together with and deemed part of the Clothing Trade Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1940, No. 2 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

3. Clause 2 of the principal Order is revoked and the following clause substituted therefor:—

"2. This Order applies to female workers who, after reaching the age of twenty-one years, commence employment in the shirt, white, and silk-working trade or in the dressmaking and millinery trade."

4. This Order shall come into effect on the day of the date hereof.
