Price Order No. 476 (Amending Price Order No. 317) (Apples and Pears)

PURSUANT to the powers conferred on it by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,* the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following amending Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 476, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 317† (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).
2. This Order shall come into force on the 14th day of January, 1946.
3. The First and Second Schedules to the principal Order, as set out in Price Orders No. 449† and No. 408†, are hereby revoked, and the following Schedules substituted therefor respectively:—

Town Land in Auckland Land District for Selection on Renewable Lease

Applicants should appear personally for examination at the Auckland District Lands and Survey Office, Auckland, on Tuesday, 26th February, 1946, at 10.30 o'clock a.m., but if any applicant is unable to attend he may be examined by any other Land Board or by any Commissioner of Crown Lands.

The ballot will be held immediately upon conclusion of the examination of applicants, and the successful applicant is required to pay immediately at conclusion of ballot a deposit comprising the first half-year's rent, broken-period rent, lease fee, and deposit in reduction of weighting for improvements.
