A PROCLAMATION

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby set apart for a mine rescue-station; and I do also hereby declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the eighth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and forty-six.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of Crown land set apart: 14.1 perches.  
Being closed road adjoining part Section 16 and Section 17, Village of Torea.

Situated in Block I, Ngakawau Survey District (Nelson R.D.) (S.O. 9410.)
