## Price Order No. 518 (Paint-N.Z. Paint and Varnish Co., Ltd.)

PURSUANT to the powers conferred on it by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,\* the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following Price Order :---

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 518, and shall come into force on the 17th day of April, 1946.

### APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

2. This Order applies only with respect to paint manufactured by the N.Z. Paint and Varnish Co., Ltd., of the several kinds specified in the Schedule hereto.

(1) The maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for any paint to which this Order applies that is sold in the City of Palmerston North or the boroughs of Napier or Hastings shall be the appropriate price fixed in the Schedule hereto.
(2) The maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for any paint to which this Order applies that is sold elsewhere than in the City of Palmerston North or the boroughs of Napier or Hastings shall be the appropriate price fixed in the Schedule hereto.
