## Price Order No. 524 (Paint-Best Paints, Ltd.)

PURSUANT to the powers conferred on it by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,\* the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following Price Order :--

 This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 524, and shall come into force on the 17th day of April, 1946.
 (1) Price Orders No. 2407, 2412, 2428, and 450|| are hereby revoked.
 (2) The revocation of the said Orders shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the coming into force of this Order. APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

3. This Order applies only with respect to paint manufactured by Best Paints, Ltd., of the several kinds specified in the Schedule hereto.

## FIXING MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES OF PAINT TO WHICH THIS ORDER APPLIES

4. (1) The maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for any paint to which this Order applies that is sold in the City of Auckland or the City of Wellington shall be the appropriate price fixed in the Schedule hereto. (2) The maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for any paint to which this Order applies that is sold elsewhere than in the City of Auckland or the City of Wellington shall be the appropriate price fixed in the Schedule hereto. part of any transport or other charges actually and reasonably incurred by the retailer in obtaining delivery into his store : Provided that the amount added in respect of such charges shall not in any case exceed 1s. per gallon on the lines sold by measure or 6s. per hundredweight

(3) If in respect of any lot of paint sold by a retailer the maximum price calculated in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this clause is not an exact number of pence or half-pence, the maximum price of the lot shall be computed to the nearest upward halfpenny. SCHEDULE
