- 4. (I) The maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for any paint to which this Order applies that is sold in any of the cities or boroughs of Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, Dunedin, Invercargill, Whangarei, Hamilton, Napier, Hastings, Wanganui, Palmerston North, Lower Hutt, Petone, Nelson, Greymouth, or Timaru shall be the appropriate price fixed in the Schedule hereto.
- (2) The maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for any paint to which this Order applies that is sold elsewhere than at one of the places mentioned in the last preceding subclause shall be the appropriate price fixed in the Schedule hereto, increased by a proportionate part of any transport or other charges actually and reasonably incurred by the retailer in obtaining delivery into his store: Provided that the amount added in respect of such charges shall not in any case exceed 1s. per gallon on the lines sold by measure or 6s.

per hundredweight on the lines sold by weight.

(3) If in respect of any lot of paint sold by a retailer the maximum price calculated in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this clause is not an exact number of pence or half-pence, the maximum price of the lot shall be computed to the nearest upward halfpenny.
