Authorizing the Laying-off of a Road of less Width than 66 ft.

HEREAS in the opinion of the Minister of Lands it is inexpedient, by reason of the fact that the land shown upon the plan of Town of Paraparaumu Beach Extension No. 15 affecting Ngarara West A No. 73, situated in Block III, Kapiti Survey District, Wellington Land District, is intended to be used wholly for residential purposes, that Mahana Road thereon should be of the width of 66 ft.
