

Appointing a Commissioner of the Lower Clutha River Trust

WHEREAS by Warrant dated the 13th day of June, 1944, and published in *Gazette* No. 49 of the 15th day of the same month, Andrew Alex Jensen, of Stirling, Farmer, was appointed a Commissioner of the Lower Clutha River Trust in terms of section 3, subsection (1), of the Lower Clutha River Improvement Act, 1938:

Now, therefore, I, Robert Semple, the Minister of Works, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 3, subsection (1), of the Lower Clutha River Improvement Act, 1938, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby cancel the appointment of the said Andrew Alex Jensen to be a Commissioner of the Lower Clutha River Trust and do hereby appoint John William Fenton, Esquire, of Kaitangata, to be a Commissioner of the Lower Clutha River Trust.
