The Levin Milk Delivery Notice 1943, Amendment No. 2

1. This notice may be cited as the Levin Milk Delivery Notice 1943, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Levin Milk Delivery Notice 1943† (hereinafter referred to as the principal scheme).

2. Clause (1) of the principal scheme is hereby amended in relation to the description of the term "the plan," by deleting the words "Transport Department at Wellington under No. TT. 3387," and substituting the words "Milk Marketing Division of the Marketing Department at Wellington under the No. M.M.D. 7."

3. Clause (6) of the principal scheme is hereby revoked and the following clause is substituted therefor:—

"(6) The names of the vendors who are parties to this scheme and the areas in which they may deliver milk are as follows:—
