And whereas it is expedient to authorize the said local authority to raise portion of the said loan amounting to two thousand four hundred pounds (£2,400) (hereinafter called the said sum) on the

hundred pounds (£2,400) (hereinafter called the said sum) on the conditions hereinafter set out:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, and in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by section eleven of the said Act, as set out in section twenty-nine of the Finance Act, 1932 (No. 2), and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby consent to the raising in New Zealand by the said local authority of the said sum up to the amount of two thousand four hundred pounds (£2,400), and in giving such consent doth hereby determine as follows:—

(1) The term for which the said sum or any part thereof may be raised shall not exceed seven (7) years.

(2) The rate of interest that may be paid in respect of the said sum or any part thereof shall be such as shall not produce to the lender or lenders a rate exceeding three pounds fifteen shillings (62.15x) per contrary per anyty. (£3 15s.) per centum per annum.
