*Revoking Extended-river and Partially Smooth-water Limits for the Port of Whakatane and defining Others in lieu thereof*

IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon me by section 189 of the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, I, James O'Brien, Minister of Marine, do hereby revoke the Whakatane extended-river and partially smooth-water limits, as defined by Warrant dated the 2nd day of August, 1934, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 9th August, 1934, at page 2457, and do hereby define the following extended-river and partially smooth-water limits for the Port of Whakatane in lieu thereof:—

"Inside a line extending 045° for 7½ miles from the western point of the River Matata outlet as charted on Admiralty Chart No. 2527, dated 23rd July, 1906, and thence direct to Opape Point."
