Allocating Railway Land to the Purposes of Road in Block XIII, Turanganui Survey District

[L.S.] B. C. FREYBERG, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section two hundred and twenty-six of the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land which is described in the Schedule hereto (and which was taken for the Gisborne-Waikokopu section of the East Coast Main Trunk Railway and in the purposition of the East Coast Main Trunk Railway and is not now required for such purpose) shall, upon the publication hereof in the New Zealand Gazette, become road, and that such road shall be maintained by the Main Highways Board in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained by the said Board.
