*The Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943—Notice declaring Land taken for the Settlement of Discharged Servicemen*

**W**HEREAS, pursuant to section 24 of the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943, notice was given of the intention of the Minister of Lands to take under Part II of the said Act the lands described in the Schedule hereto, and a copy of the said notice was published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on the 10th day of January, 1946, at page 24:

And whereas an objection was made by the owners in the manner prescribed by the said Act objecting to the taking of the said lands and claiming the right to retain a part of the said lands:

And whereas the owners withdrew such objection and agreed to an amended vesting date:

And whereas the said lands are not the lands of any serviceman who is for the time being serving outside New Zealand in any of His Majesty's Forces or in any British ship:

Now, therefore, the Minister of Lands, acting in pursuance of section 27 of the said Act, doth hereby declare that the said lands are taken for the settlement of discharged servicemen, and hereby specifies the 28th day of February, 1947, as the date on which the said lands shall be deemed to be vested in His Majesty the King.
