HASTINGS BOROUGH COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Hastings Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £74,300, authorized to be raised by the Hastings Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of carrying out road sealing and footpath formation, extension of water mains, improvements to storm-water drainage system, and sewerage extensions, the said Hastings Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of ninety-two one-hundredths (92/100ths) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (upon the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property appearing on the valuation roll of the Borough of Hastings, comprising the whole borough; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be due and payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five (25) years or until the loan is fully paid off."

The foregoing resolution was passed at a meeting of the Hastings Borough Council held on Thursday, 17th October, 1946.
