Prohibiting Alienation of Native Land other than Alienation in favour of the Crown

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section four hundred and forty-two of the Native Land Act, 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby prohibit all alienation of the Native land described in the Schedule hereto other than alienation in favour of the Crown.

SCHEDULE

FIRST, all that parcel of land containing 700 acres, more or less, situate in Block XIV, Puketapu Survey District, and Blocks II and III, Maungaku Survey District, being part of the block known as Puketapu 3A.

Secondly, all that parcel of land containing 670 acres, more or less, situate in Block XIV, Puketapu Survey District, and Blocks I, II, and III, Maungaku Survey District, being part of the block of land known as Puketapu 3A.

Thirdly, all that parcel of land containing 45 acres, more or less, situate in Block I, Maungaku Survey District, being part of the block of land known as Puketapu 3B 8.

Fourthly, all that parcel of land containing 110 acres, more or less, situate in Block XIV, Puketapu Survey District, and Blocks I and II, Maungaku Survey District, being part of the block of land known as Puketapu 3B 9.
